First Parish Choir

The First Parish Choir is the cornerstone of the music program. The choir sings almost every Sunday at one of the two services (9:00 on the first two Sundays of the month, 11:00 for the rest). In addition to regular Sunday services, the choir sings on Christmas Eve and prepares larger choral works for special "Music Sundays" during the year.

The choir is for those who love to sing in a group and enjoy the unique community of a singing organization. It is composed of adult men and women, though interested high school singers are also encouraged to join. No previous choir experience is necessary. The ability to read music is helpful, but not required.

Handbell Choir

The Bell Choir regularly provides music for church services and performs for the wider community in Concord. Traditionally, they play in church on Christmas Eve and on Palm Sunday. They also play for church functions throughout the year.

Junior Choir – Grades 1-3

Members of the Junior Choir gather in the safety of a song circle where they are encouraged to discover the inherent beauty of their voices through shared song. Song selections reflect the wide diversity of cultural and religious traditions welcomed and celebrated in our UU faith. The Junior Choir sings at approximately 8 worship services during the year, including Christmas Eve, sometimes combining with other First Parish Choirs.

Chalice Choir – Grades 4 to 6

Members of the Chalice Choir are empowered to assert their choral voices and take fun risks as they begin to learn about their integral role within worship leadership. Song selections reflect the wide diversity of cultural and religious traditions welcomed and celebrated in our UU faith. The Chalice Choir sings at approximately 8 worship services during the year, including Christmas Eve, sometimes combining with other First Parish Choirs.

Gospel Choir – Grades 7 - 12

Through learning and performing music of the Gospel tradition, singers will be empowered to share their musical talents with the congregation and to develop their leadership potential for the benefit of our church. Singers and instrumentalists (keyboard, bass, and percussion) are invited to join the group. The Gospel Choir will provide music leadership in several services scheduled throughout the church year, including Christmas Eve.

New in 2009! Threshold Choir

Partnering with the First Parish pastoral care ministry, the Threshold Choir taps into an ancient tradition of singing at the bedsides of those who are struggling with illness or approaching death. At their meetings, singers learn simple, healing music such as hymns, chants, lullabies, rounds and spirituals to support one another and, when invited, to share with parishioners in need of healing, in homes, hospitals and hospice beds. The group is open to any adult who loves to sing and longs to serve through music.
